Alex's Eating House

This humble Beach Road kopitiam (opposite Shaw Towers) dishes out succulent roast duck, BBQ pork, and sees big lunchtime crowds. For pre-concert dining only.

Crystal Jade Seafood Kitchen (Holland Village)

This branch of the successful Cantonese chain of restaurants on Lorong Mambong is a favourite with musicians, especially after Open Air concerts at the Botanic Gardens. Open till very late.

Thai Express, Esplanade

Possibly the busiest F&B outlet at Esplanade. Almost everybody comes here for its pad thai (fried rice noodles), stuffed chicken wings and green seafood curry. But beware of the pre-concert jam, or you'll be late and locked out!

Fatty Weng Restaurant

Located in Geylang (Guillemard Road) next to the Singapore Badminton Hall, this non-air-conditioned wing is famous for its claypot liver, fried fish and oyster:
